



Intercollegiate Meat Judging Code of Conduct

“For the enhancement of the Meat Judging Program, it is anticipated that students and coaches participating in the Intercollegiate Meat Judging Program will adhere to the principle of representing themselves and their schools with professionalism and in consideration of others at all times. It is the responsibility of the individual coach, and not that of the American Meat Science Association, to monitor the activities of student contestants, to include (but not be limited to) underage drinking, excessive noise, and destruction of property. Repeated violation of the above principle could result in loss of sponsorship for the Intercollegiate Meat Judging Program.

“In the event violations do occur, these will be reported to the Executive Committee of the Intercollegiate Meat Coaches Association for review and action. Such violations could result in loss of eligibility for individuals and/or institutions.

“In addition, individuals and/or institutions will be fully responsible for restitution of property damage resulting from such an incident.”
